- your payment for seasonal, alternate-week, or per-diem participation (\$150 for seasonal [\$175 after March 15]; \$95 for alternate-week; \$20 per market day for per-diem); please make all payments by check or money order, payable to the Acton-Boxborough Farmers Market; your check will be cashed once you are accepted as a 2011 ABFM Vendor
